Overview

Matford Brook Academy will open in a purpose-built school site on the southern edge of Exeter within the Haldon Reach development. Run in association with the Ofsted (2022) Outstanding Marine Academy Primary, it is an all-through school for children ages 2-16 built with capacity for 59 nursery places, 630 primary pupils and 750 secondary pupils. Due to open in September 2023, the initial cohort will be for nursery, Reception and Year 7 pupils with the school growing year-on-year to full capacity.

Our Vision - We write our own story

Why a new school?

The city has a growing population with plans indicating the potential for 9000 new jobs and 13000 new homes. With nearby schools at or near capacity, Local Authority planners have confirmed the need for new primary and secondary school places.

This new development is analogous to that at Cranbrook in East Devon where the Trust opened a similar all-through school in September 2015. Nursery provision has proved essential in supporting the new community, hence Matford Brook Academy's design as an all-through school with provision for 2 years olds upwards.

The development area includes the building of the new school with exceptional facilities (see below). This is purposefully adjacent to the first phase of residential development in the Haldon Reach estate to promote the takeup of new housing and avoid the placing of undue strain on existing schools.

A projected 2300+ houses are set to be developed within the Teignbridge development up to 2032.

Facilities

Matford Brook Academy will open in a purpose-built two storey and three storey element building.

Covering approximately 9,196sqm, the state-of-the-art building will provide excellent facilities such as a fully equipped theatre with raked seating, activity studio, spacious learning and resources centre and two recreational halls in addition to a dedicated dining hall.

The extensive sport facilities include a traditionally built four court sports hall, a large 3G artificial turf all-weather flood lit pitches, netball courts, a full sized adult football pitch, a cricket square, a full sized adult rugby pitch, 400m athletics track and field provision, an outdoor learning environment including woodland area and a four-court Tarmacadam multi-use games area (MUGA) parking and amenity space. These facilities provide opportunity for extensive community use.
