## 1. Remote learning

During the COVID-19 lockdowns, schools were expected to provide a remote learning offer to ensure that all pupils could continue with their curriculum.

Although there is no longer a remote learning offer as the government requires pupils to attend school in person, Matford Brook Academy has provision should there be school closures in the future.

## 2. Learning platforms

Matford Brook Academy is a Microsoft institution. All resources related to curriculum, teaching and learning are stored using Sharepoint and Microsoft Teams. All staff and pupils have a Microsoft account, allowing them access to the resources applicable to them.

In the event of school closures, pupils would have access to their learning in the following ways:

- Live lessons via Microsoft Teams
- Curriculum resources from their class teacher, stored in Sharepoint
- Uploaded work given feedback by their teacher via class Notebooks on Microsoft Teams
