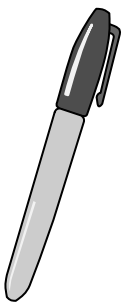




School Uniform

Please label all of your child's uniform and equipment clearly with their first and last name as we cannot accept responsibility for items which are lost or mislaid. This can be done effectively with a permanent marker written on internal labels; the more expensive and aggressively marketed alternatives are not necessary! We will teach the children helpful routines to look after their belongings but, inevitably, sometimes things are mislaid. These can be quickly returned if they are clearly named.

Uniform essentials

- MBA-pinafore (non-branded gingham dress in summer) or;
- Charcoal grey trousers (shorts in summer)
- Non-branded navy polo shirt, plain with collar
- Branded cardigan or sweatshirt
- Branded bookbag
- Black socks or tights
- Plain navy shorts (or joggers in winter)
- Plain white cre-neck t-shirt for PE days

Uniform optional

- PE bag - useful but not essential

Wellies

All pupils will also require a pair of wellies which can be kept at school. We will be enjoying our outdoor spaces in all weathers

School shoes

Our primary pupils will be active throughout the day, not just in PE sessions. Therefore, their school shoes should be safe for running, jumping and having fun!

Please ensure shoes are black and fit well. We will be working on promoting your child's independence and so please do not put them in laced or buckled school shoes until they are able to do up and undo their laces or buckles independently.

for PE:

Pupils should wear black plimsolls or trainers with a non-marking sole. Your child's PE bag will stay in school during term time so please don't put shoes in their PE bag which you will need at home during term time



School Equipment



Pupils should limit the equipment they come to school with to support their growing independence in organising their belongings.

They may need:

- A drinks bottle containing water or sugar free squash which is brought in daily
- A labelled bottle of suncream in sunny weather (this should always be applied before school by an adult at home first)
- A sun hat in warm weather



In Chapter 1 your child will receive a daily free fruit snack and therefore no further snacks are required. We will provide all equipment your child needs to learn and play; therefore, your child does not need to bring anything such as a pencil case or their own toys. These are much more important at home!

We'll be supporting your child to learn to care for and organise their own belongings. It's really helpful if their items are labelled to help with this. When they start, please share examples with us when you notice them starting to use their wonderful tidying and organising skills at home so we can celebrate these at school.
