# Our Transition Pledge



We will do everything we can to ensure that every Ted Wragg Trust (TWT) child has the best possible transition between primary and secondary schools. We will stay in contact with primary schools and provide contact details so communication can be effective.

We will provide every child with exciting opportunities, including:

- · every child will receive a copy of 'Wonder' to read by the time they start secondary school (an audio file is also available).
- a chance to complete a writing task, writing 'their story' so far to share with their new tutor introducing themselves, what their hobbies are, what they are looking forward to about starting at their secondary school and what they are worried about.
- an introductory Maths course via our exciting and highly successful SPARX programme. 'Sparx Maths' (SMVC / Sparx Maths virtual classroom). This programme is used to deliver Maths in all Trust secondary schools.
- a knowledge organiser 'Our story at Matford Brook Academy' - with information about our school.

We are really pleased that Hannah is joining the inaugural staff leadership team for Matford Brook Academy. An experienced colleague, including as a SENDCo with the National Award for Special Educational Needs Co-Ordination, Hannah will be one of our Deputy Headteachers. Hannah grew up in Somerset and studied English at university. Having worked abroad at an international school, she qualified as a teacher in 2007, beginning her teaching career in Coventry. She moved to Devon and worked in a variety of teaching and school leadership roles from 2010.

#### School visits
